



DO NOT ACCEPT THE

- 1. Always inspect the packaging for signs of damage.
- 2. Inspect all ShockWatch and TiltWatch indicators (one each on outside and inside crate). If indicators are red (as shown) note on delivery form.
- 3. Describe any damage to the package or product on the Bill of Lading/Delivery Form.





- 4. If there is damage, the driver should call it in to their office immediately and provide information for filing the freight claim.
- 5. Have the driver sign or initial next to any notations.
- 6. Keep a copy of the driver's paper work.
- 7. Mazzei must be notified in writing of any shortages within 7 days of receipt.
