**SUMMARY DESCRIPTION:** Responsible for managing fabrication operations to ensure fabrication shop operates efficiently, throughput is optimized, workplace safety procedures are followed and Mazzei's quality standards are maintained.

**ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS:**

Extensive knowledge and experience in the manufacturing of stainless steel products and components, and related complex skidded systems. Effective at providing direction and coordination of all manufacturing and production, including quality control, vendor management, scheduling and external fabrication shop management. Successful at identifying, documenting and implementing cost effective fabrication and assembly processes and reducing costs.

Possess strong knowledge of industry safety and quality standards and effective communication and problem-solving abilities related to fabrication processes. Handles complex issues and problems and refers only the most complex issues to other Company staff.

Leads, directs, and trains 2-5 employees. Has some authority for personnel decisions related to hiring, performance, or disciplinary actions. Performs work with limited supervision. Provides coaching, training and/or mentoring to direct reports and fellow employees.

Typically requires an associate degree, accreditation from a technical school, or an applicable skilled trades program, and at least 7 years of experience.

**ADDITIONAL DUTIES and RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Manage welding activities (GTAW, GMAW) and ensure fabrication is performed in accordance with applicable drawings and/or specifications;
- Perform more complex or higher priority welding, as needed;
- Review SolidWorks drawings and consult with Engineering to optimize functionality, design integrity, and ease of fabrication, as well as ensure meeting any customer dictated requirements (e.g., clearance);
- Proactively review pending workflow with Project Team to ensure all parts and components are available (e.g., gaskets, fasteners, strut, and strut Accessories, conduit, etc);
- Develop and qualify Mazzei Welding Procedures to meet product and customer requirements;
- Ensure that all Quality Control processes (including Weld Maps and Heat Maps) are followed, and applicable QC documentation is properly completed and submitted on a timely basis;
- Mentor and develop fabrication staff;
- Follow and maintain knowledge of current safety protocols and requirements and keep workplace in safe condition;

- Oversee allocation of fabrication work between internal (i.e., Mazzei Fabrication Shop) and external (i.e., third-party Fabrication Shops) resources to ensure efficient and timely completion of product fabrication;
- Coordinate and supervise external welding shops, fostering strong partnerships and ensuring the timely delivery of quality components;
- Provide monthly reporting of throughput and cost variances.

- Accreditation from a technical school or an applicable skilled trades program preferred;
- Authorization to work in the U.S. is a precondition of employment.

- Knowledgeable in industrial safety practices and procedures.
